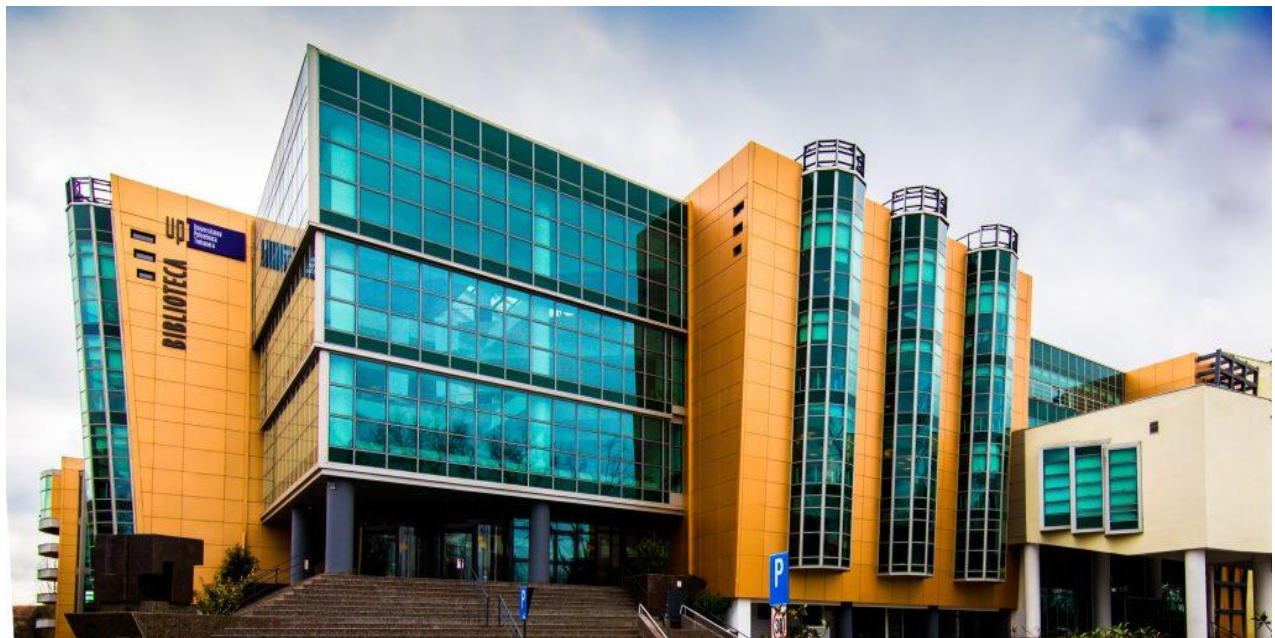
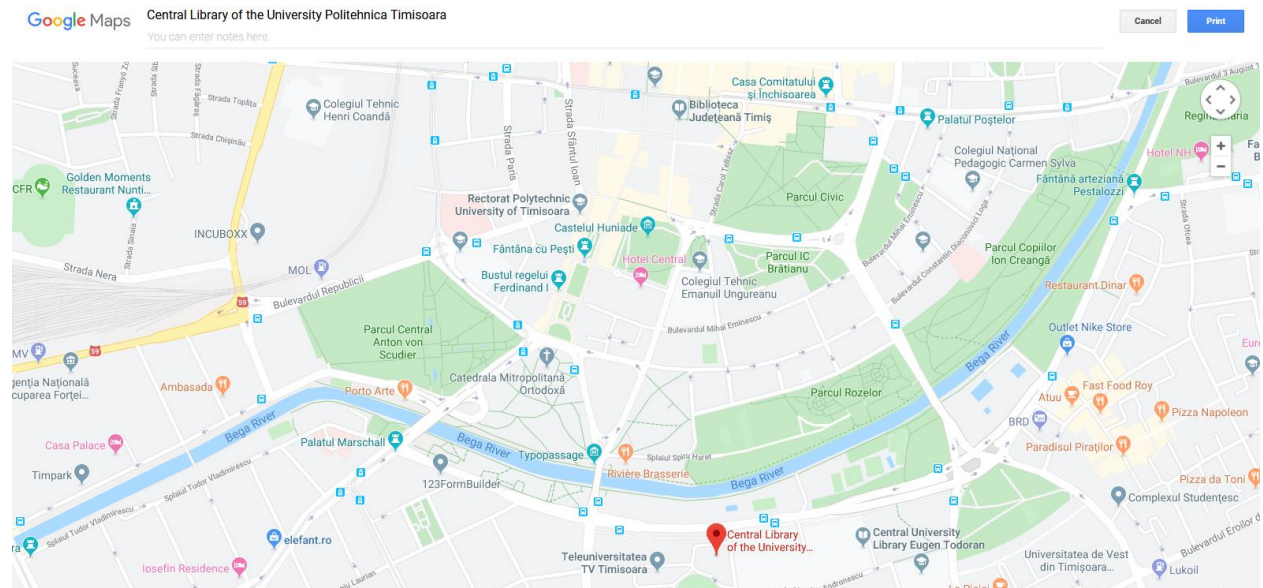

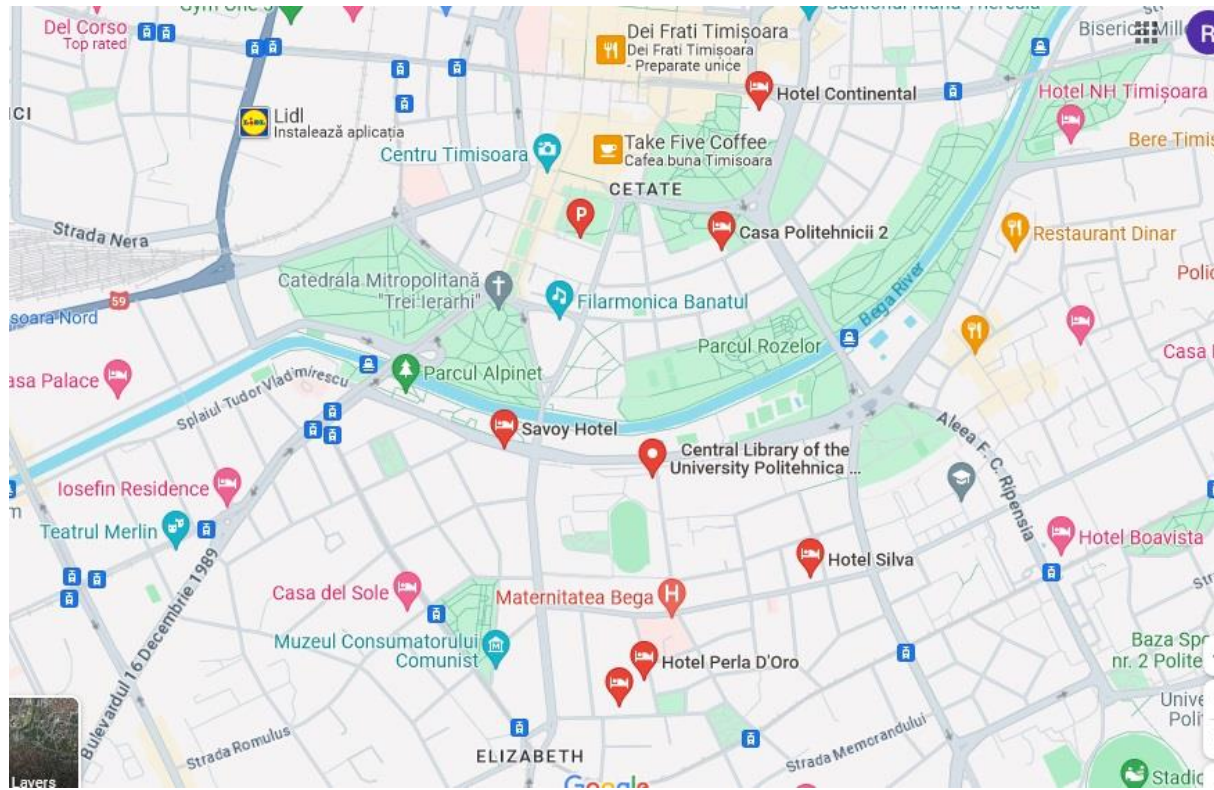

## Travel

**By plane:** The best option is to fly directly to Timișoara. [The International Airport of Timișoara](#) (TSR), located at 10 kilometers from the city centre, is offering direct flights to Bucharest, Munich, Paris-Beauvais, London-Luton, Brussels-Charleroi, Dortmund, Frankfurt-Hahn, Munich West-Memmingen, Bari, Milano, Bologna, Rome, Venice, Barcelona, Madrid, Valencia (provided by TAROM, Lufthansa, Wizz Air, HiSky).

The second option is to fly to [Budapest](#) or [Cluj-Napoca](#), then take the shuttle or a train (the travel should last approximately 4 to 6 hours).

The third option is to fly to [Bucharest](#), then take another flight to Timișoara or reach it by train or by bus.

**By train:** It takes 3 hours to reach Timișoara by train from Belgrade (Serbia), 6 hours from Budapest (Hungary) and about 8 hours from Bucharest (Romania). For information about domestic trains please access the [Romanian Railways website](#). For international train connections all over Europe, please access the [Austrian Railways website](#). Look for "Timisoara Nord" railway station.

**By car:** As Timișoara is situated in the western part of Romania, maybe it is easier to travel by car, especially if you come from Serbia, Hungary, Poland, Slovakia or Austria.

## How to reach Casa Politehnicii 2 from the airport

1. By the express bus E4, operated by the public transportation company, you go up to the *Bastion station*, situated close to the city center. Then, it is 5 minutes walking distance to the Casa Politehnicii 2.
2. By TAXI, waiting near the exit door of the airport. We recommend one of the following local companies: Radio Taxi - 0256 940; Tudo Taxi - 0256 945; Euro Taxi - 0256 941; Fan Taxi - 0256 944 and the ridesharing companies Uber and Bolt.

## **Timișoara**

**Timișoara** is one of the most important academic, cultural and economic centers in Romania. It is situated in the western part of Romania, where three countries - Romania, Hungary and Serbia - and several cultures, nationalities, languages and customs converge. Timișoara is the place where the 1989 Romanian Revolution started on December 17. It is at the heart of the Banat region, which is famous for its beauty, wealth, agriculture and hospitable people. Nearby is the famous Recea vineyard, with an increasing worldwide recognition for the quality of its wines <http://www.recaswine.ro/>.

Timișoara means not only economic activity but also social and cultural life. The past and the present meet in this 700 year old, but very European city. A medieval citadel, the Cathedral, baroque monuments and attractive modern buildings complete a wonderful panorama. Numerous parks and the river Bega with its romantic bridges are just some of the features of this city. Cinemas, theatres, an opera house, bars and restaurants, sport facilities and local festivals offer a lots of possibilities to spend your spare time in this beautiful academic city, full of students. In 2023 Timisoara was designated [\*European Capital of Culture\*](#).

Nowadays Timișoara is considered the Silicon Valley of the Central and East Europe due to several world-class high-tech companies which have opened the development and production units in the area.
